WHAT IS FOG?

Fat, Oil & Grease (FOG) come from meats, butter and margarine, food scraps, sauces, salad dressings, dairy products and cooking oil.

FOG is a real pain in the drain! When grease laden water, greasy food scraps and other debris enter the sewer system, FOG can build up on the pipe walls and block flow, causing wastewater to back up and flow into our streets, storm drain or even back into the kitchen. This is called a sanitary sewer overflow (SSO).

HOW TO HELP

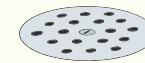
Call 959 to order your kitchen oil container

✓ Do

BEFORE WASHING POTS, PANS & DISHES



- ✓ Wipe off oil and grease with a dry paper towel



- ✓ Make sure drain screens are in place



- ✓ Scrap leftover food into the organic bin

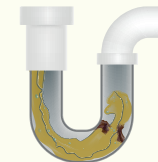


- ✓ Pour your cooled oil into a covered container and place it next to your recycling bin

- ✗ Don't pour oil & grease down the drain



- ✗ Don't put food scraps down the drain



- ✗ Don't rinse off oil & grease from your pans & fryers down the drain
