## Paper and Cardboard

- ✓ Newsprint and household paper
- ✓ Magazines and catalogues
- ✓ Non-foil gift wrap
- ✓ Paper egg cartons
- ✓ Paperback books
- ✓ Cardboard boxes
- ✓ Pizza boxes

### Plastic

✓ Household bottles and containers (e.g. vinegar, shampoo, detergent, margarine, yogurt etc.) If unsure !!! Dispose in the recycling bin

## Metal

- ✓ Metal food cans
- ✓ Aluminum travs
- ✓ Empty non-hazardous aerosol cans
- ✓ Coffee Capsules

## Glass

✓ Glass jars and bottles only (not broken)

## **Beverage Containers**

Milk containers, juice boxes, beverage bottles, soda cans
